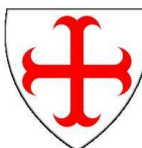


## LORDS OF THE MANOR OF WICKHAM

1066 - 1072	<b>Huge de Port</b>	Norman Sheriff of Kent(?)
1072 -c1129	<b>Henry de Port</b>	Son of Hugh
? - ?	<b>John de Port</b>	
? - ?	<i>not known</i>	
c1250 - 1287	<b>Roger de Scures</b>	Obtained Charter for a Fair from Henry III
1287 - 1337	<b>Matthew de Scures</b>	Then <b>Eva de Scures</b> , Matthew's daughter
1337 - 1353	<b>Sir John de Scures</b>	Matthew's cousin. Warden of Winchester Castle
1353 - 1381	<b>John de Scures</b>	Then <b>Sybilla de Scures</b> , John's daughter
1381 - 1399	<b>John Uvedale</b>	Sybilla's husband
1399 - ?	<b>William Uvedale</b>	John's son
? -c1438	<b>John Uvedale</b>	John's son
c1438 - 1474	<b>Sir Thomas Uvedale</b>	Sheriff of Hampshire, Surrey and Sussex
<i>Estates held by the Crown - William Uvedale attained for High Treason - later pardoned.</i>		
1485 - 1529	<b>William Uvedale</b>	Sheriff of Hants. Conveyed estates before death
c1524 - 1530	<b>Dorothy Uvedale</b>	Wife of William
1530 - 1537	<b>Arthur Uvedale</b>	Son of Dorothy, "Of weak intellect"
1528 - 1569	<b>Sir William Uvedale</b>	Married the daughter of the Lord Mayor of London
1560 - 1615	<b>Sir William Uvedale</b>	Marquis of Winchester
1616 - 1632	<b>Mary Uvedale</b>	Wife of William Uvedale. <i>Manor held by the Crown.</i>
1587 - 1652	<b>Sir William Uvedale</b>	Treasurer to Privy Chamber of James I & Charles I
<i>Division of the estates between daughters Victoria (1643-1683 wife of Sir Richard Corbet) and Elizabeth (1646-1696 wife of the Earl of Carlisle)</i>		
1663 - 1696	<b>Sir Uvedale Corbett</b>	Son of Victoria Uvedale
1663 - 1724	<b>Earl of Carlisle</b>	Husband of Elizabeth Uvedale.
<i>Sale of the estates: Sir Uvedale Corbett in 1720, Earl of Carlisle in 1719)</i>		
1690 - 1764	<b>Jonathan Rashleigh</b>	Cornish family
1764 - 1766	<b>Phillip Rashleigh</b>	<i>Sale of the estates in 1765</i>
1739 - 1835	<b>Sir George Garnier</b>	Sheriff of Hampshire
1772 - 1835	<b>William Garnier</b>	Daughter Lucy marries John Carpenter JP
1800 - 1863	<b>William Garnier</b>	No issue. Title passes to John Carpenter JP
1839 - 1926	<b>John Carpenter-Garnier</b>	(John Carpenter JP - name change)
1877 - 1960	<b>George William Carpenter-Garnier</b>
