Arriving from A32

Take the A32 (Gosport Road) through Fareham until you arrive at Fort Brockhurst. At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit for Rowner Road (B3334). At the next roundabout take the 1st exit into Grange Road. Continue on Grange Road until the turning on the right for Howe Road (signposted **17th Century Village Experience**). Continue down Howe Road and take the first turning on the left for Little Woodham Lane (look for the brown sign). Follow Little Woodham Lane until you reach the end, where it opens out in to a grassed parking area in front of Grange Farm. Please park on the grass outside the farm house.

Access Information

There are 4 steps to the main entrance. Routes / pathways throughout the village are suitable for visitors with limited mobility. Seating is available, at appropriate intervals, for visitors with limited mobility.
